THE BENEFITS OF OUR PROGRAM

Since 2012, over **6,000 students** actively participated in our year-long program, achieving an impressive average of a **71% increase** in financial and investment knowledge. Notably, RTSWS alumnae are **5 times** more likely than the average female university student to pursue degrees or careers in finance, economics, or related business fields after completing our courses over three out of their four high school years.
