VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Given that we are a full academic year long program, there are ample opportunities for you or your employee to participate from September through April. RTSWS offers multiple volunteer opportunities for all levels of company employees - from your recent college graduate to your C-level executive.

Classroom Instructor

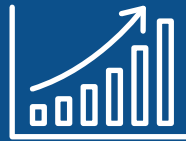
Facilitate financial literacy workshops for RTSWS turn-key current curriculum. Class sizes are typically 20-25 girls

MENTOR/ PROTEGE PROGRAM

Mentor

Guide high school girls (with provided RTSWS curriculum.)

Training

One 1-hour session video

Mentor Sessions

Three 1-hour sessions at local high school once per month, Feb - April

Fall Financial Literacy Workshops 4 - 6 volunteers

These are four one-hour sessions held at your partner high school, once a week during the fall semester. Each volunteer only needs to attend two to three sessions. RTSWS works out the logistical details of dates, times and meeting space with the school.

Fall "Wall Street Experience" Field Trip 8 - 10 volunteers

This is a four hour "lunch & learn" style event. RTSWS will provide a sample agenda for you to plan from. Your program coordinators can also assist with some of the volunteer roles and/or identifying a host site if needed.

Spring Mentoring Sessions estimated 8 - 12 volunteers based on enrollment

Three one-hour sessions spread out from February to April. Mentors are paired with proteges and attend every session. RTSWS takes care of the scheduling with the partner school.
